Grounds for Exemption from Common Units

Students may receive CRDT-TRANS for two Common Units (CUC100 or CUC106 and CUC107) in the event that they:

- Already completed one or both (or equivalent units) in another course; or
- Completed a higher education award at AQF Level 5 or above (other than a nested course);
 or
- Completed the equivalent of 80 credit points towards a higher education award at another HE Provider at AQF Level 6 or above; or
- Completed a VET award at AQF Level 4 or above, and the Common Unit Theme Leader has determined that the learning outcomes attained are equivalent;

Students may receive CRDT-TRANS for one of the academic literacy Common Units (CUC100 and CUC106) in the event that they:

- Have successfully completed the first year or more of another undergraduate degree; or
- Have achieved a credit or above in the Academic Language and Learning unit and the Tertiary Computing unit from the Tertiary Enabling Program; or
- Have achieved 65% and above overall, as well as for their essay and exam, in the Navitas Academic English 3 course; or
- As a Year 12 graduate enrolling in a CDU Higher Education course, have completed their Research Project B assessment and oral presentation to the satisfaction of the Common Units Theme Leader.
- As an Essington Senior College student have achieved a credit or higher in CUC100E.
